

We had another highlight in August when Dane County Executive Melissa Agard came to Maple Wood to talk to us about her career in local government and what drew her to that work. She also explained Dane County's role in local government and answered questions. She grew up in Madison in a modest home that benefited from human service programs. It's that background, which drove her to serve on the Health and Human Needs Committee and champion the programs that helped her family get by. Her career grew as she was elected into the State Assembly in November 2012, and she served five terms in the Wisconsin State Legislature. Her work now unfortunately doesn't include improvements to the changed city bus routes, but you may have heard about the ongoing expansion of Electric Vehicle infrastructure funded by a \$13.2 million grant, or the launch of a countywide initiative to increase the production of affordable housing units by 1,765 per year. Things that help us as a community combat climate change and homelessness. Ms. Agard also encourages all of us to get involved. There are a number of County Committees that need your help and input.
